The main referral centres are the Hervey Bay, Maryborough and Bundaberg Hospitals, with rural health facilities at Gin Gin, Childers, Biggenden, Eidsvold, Mundubbera, Gayndah, Mt Perry and Monto. These Multipurpose Health Services provide access to integrated health and aged care services to smaller communities. The WBHHS serves a population of approximately 184,000 residents. The Health Service provides a variety of primary and community health services including surgical, medical, maternity, oral health, child health, school health, health promotion, environmental health, aged care, rehabilitation, sexual health and drug and alcohol services. The WBHHS also provides a comprehensive and fully integrated mental health service to residents in both the community and acute care settings.
