Our Teams

- Part of a multidisciplinary team consisting of over 700 highly trained oncology specialists
- 350 committed nursing staff in Cancer Care Services
 - Nurse Practitioner and candidate positions
 - Clinical Nurse Consultants
 - Clinical educators and facilitators

Our Services

- A day in the life of cancer care services, we provide care to:
 - 64 inpatients
 - 200 people receiving ambulatory treatment (chemotherapy, immunotherapy, supportive therapies)
 - 120 people receiving radiation therapy services
 - 300 patients receiving a clinic consultation
- To support the above activity, we will facilitate:
 - 2 multidisciplinary clinics
 - Bedside clinical handover and Structured Interdisciplinary Bedside Rounding
 - Multiple staff training sessions
