IMES provides a wide range of comprehensive services to inpatients with secondary and tertiary services across Queensland, northern New South Wales and neighbouring Pacific countries. IMES is made up of 18 specialty clinical areas, It has 178 inpatient beds, 12 day beds and provides ambulatory services with a large number of specialist clinics, procedural units, day units and

chronic disease support services. The Emergency and Trauma Centre is also part of IMES and provides emergency care to Southeast Queensland, northern New South Wales, the Northern Territory, greater Queensland and the Pacific Rim (depending on the nature of the emergency).
